# COLLEGE PROFILE



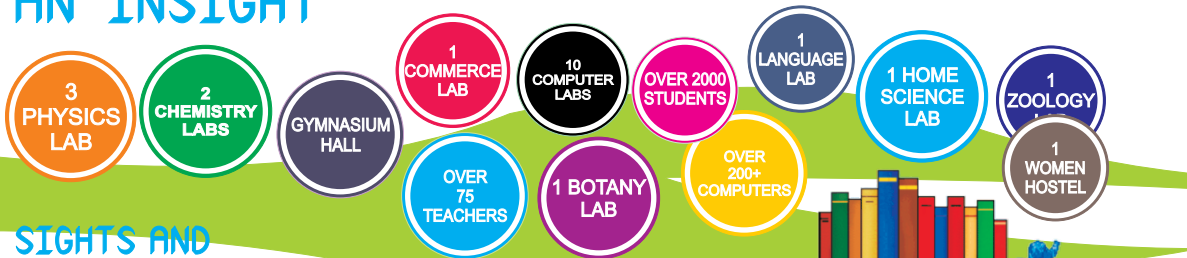

## ADMISSION RULES

### ADMISSION RULES

- The Principal reserves the right to grant or refuse admission to the college to any intending student.
- The Principal can cancel the admission of any student who has been admitted to the college, without assigning any reason what-so-ever. In that case the entire amount of dues paid by the student will be refunded to him
- The prescribed admission forms can be obtained from General Branch on payment of Rs. 250/- only and if demanded by post on payment of Rs. 300/- only.
- The Students seeking admission to the college are required to submit the following documents.:-**  
**For Under-Graduate & Postgraduate Courses:**
  - Four Passport size Photographs
  - Migration Certificate in original (except P.S.E.B and G.N.D.U.)
  - Character Certificate/ School Leaving Certificate in original from the institution last attended.
  - Certificate of Caste and income in case if S.C./S.T.
  - Transfer/ No objection certificate from the institution last attended as the case may be.
  - Photo copy of DMC of lower examination.
  - Aadhar Card copy.
  - For Gap Year Students : Original Certificate (Lower Class) within 15 days of date of admission.**
- Students who got compartment in lower examination are required to submit his/her result cards within one month after the declaration of result to avoid any penalty, before end of year.
- Those students whose result are declared late by G.N.D.U., Amritsar & P.S.E.B. can seek admission to the higher class within 10 day of the date of notification of the result without late fee, provided seats are available in class/course.
- Students admitted provisionally to any class are required to submit the original certificate of the lower examination passed within 20 days of their admission in this college failing which admission of the student stands cancelled.
- The dues once paid will not be refunded even if the students leave the college during the mid-session.
- 25 percent seats for Scheduled Castes or Scheduled Tribes, 5 percent seats for backward classes and 3% seats for Physically handicapped persons shall be reserved for admission to all the colleges affiliated to GND University, Amritsar.
- Besides the total number of seats, five seats in each course/class shall be reserved for the poor students for admission to the colleges affiliated to GND University, Amritsar as per University Calender.

### Documents in Original

Documents in Original : Any student who does not submit documents in original to the college in time, for the onward submission to the G.N.D.U., will be responsible for any loss of his/her admission, which will automatically stand cancelled and no refund will be made in any case by the college/ University. All the admission shall be provisional till confirmed by the University.

If the admission is not confirmed by the University, no Fee will be refunded. Hence before seeking admission ensure your eligibility as per university rules.



# SUBJECTS & ELIGIBILITY (2025-26)

## SPECIAL NOTE :-

1. The Subject of Drug Abuse, Prevention and Management will be taught in 1st Semester of BSc & B.A. and in 2nd Semester of B.Com, BBA, BCA & BSc (IT) of undergraduate degree classes.
2. The subject of Environmental Studies will be taught in 3rd Semester of BSc & B.A. and in 4th Semester of B.Com, BBA, BCA & BSc (IT) of undergraduate degree classes. Candidate has to clear it with at least 35% Marks in the paper & the marks obtained by the candidates **will not be added** to the **Total Marks** obtained.

## SPECIAL NOTE to select Punjabi/Punjab History & Culture/Basic Punjabi :-

1. Those Students who are domicile/non-domicile of Punjab & have studied Punjabi in matric, shall study Punjabi (Compulsory)
2. Those Students who are non-domicile of Punjab and have not studied Punjabi in matric may choose either Basic Punjabi or Punjabi History and culture.
3. Those Students who are domicile of Punjab but have studied out side Punjab for any reason and have not studied Punjabi in Matric will study only Basic Punjabi.
4. Those Students who are domicile of Punjab and have studied in Central Schools or other school in Punjab and for any reason have not studied Punjabi will study Basic Punjabi only.
